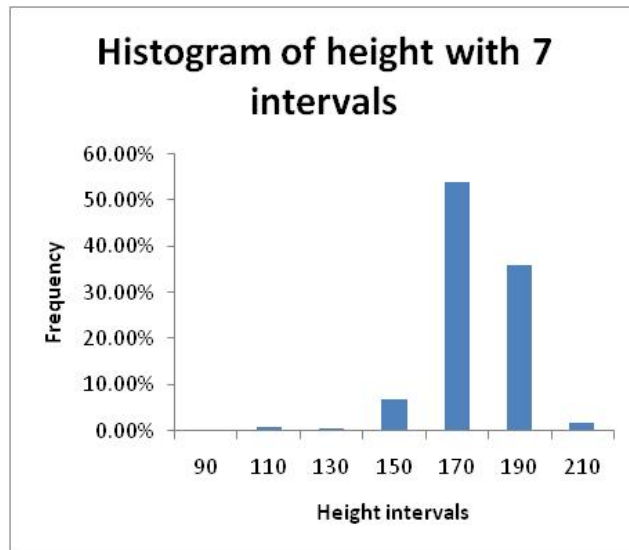
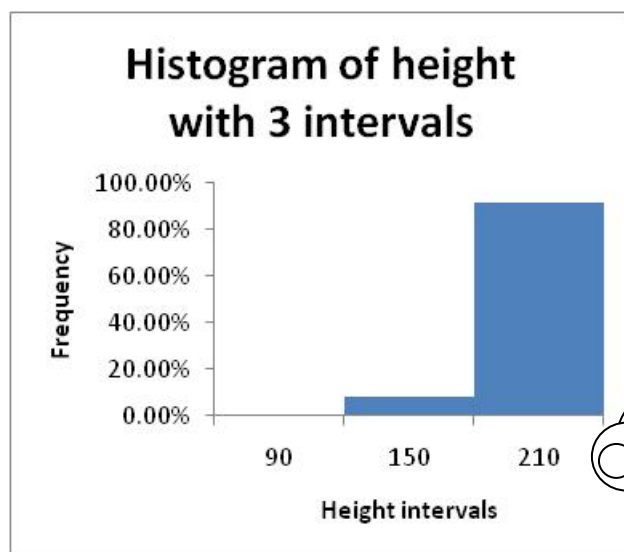


Do different groupings matter?
